Syllabus component

Through their study of **The Vikings (c. AD790-c. 1066)**, students have explored:

- the way of life in Viking society
- significant developments and/or cultural achievements
- Viking conquests and relationships with subject peoples
- and the role of significant individuals in the expansion of Viking settlement and influence.

Syllabus outcomes being assessed:

HT 4-3 Describes and assesses the motives and actions of past individuals and groups in the context of past societies

HT4-5 Identifies the meaning, purpose and context of historical sources

HT4-9 Uses a range of historical terms and concepts when communicating an understanding of the past

Description of task:

Students will participate in an open book class test.

Questions will relate to

- Where the Vikings lived and where did they travel to conquer and trade
- Their achievements
- Their everyday lives and beliefs
- Their trading and technology

They will be provided with supplementary source material.

Students will be supplied with answer sheets to write their responses on so they only need to come prepared with two blue or black pens.

This test will involve multiple choice questions and short responses with marks ranging from 1 to 4.
