Description of task: Students will create an information report based on a site study which will provide interesting written and relevant visual information. The report will include information that answers the following:- <ul style="list-style-type: none">When,Where and for Whom was The Great Pyramid of Giza built?What is the mystery about the building of the Great Pyramid and why is it such a mystery?What materials was it made from? Where did the building materials come from and how did the materials get to Giza?What are some of the facts and figures (about both the outside and inside) involved in the building of the Great Pyramid (such as number and weight of each block, size of the Pyramid, outer casing and gold top and more.)Who were the builders of the Great Pyramid? What important details do we know about the builders (you will learn as you research that the builders were NOT SLAVES) and what was one theory about how they built the Great Pyramid at Giza. (See the scaffold provided for specific details required.)
