<u>Instructions (1)</u>:

Students will research and create a photographic essay that: Reflects on the significant historical event that took place in Europe during World War Two known as 'The Holocaust.'

This will be done by

- Selecting two photos from each year of the Holocaust (1938 to 1945), a total of 16 photographs. These images may be obtained from the internet, books, documentaries or any other reliable source.
- Ensuring each image is accompanied by a title, brief description/ details of the event in the photo and where the image was found. (A guide to writing a Bibliography will be included with this task.)
- Ensuring the collection of photos tell a story and evoke emotions about the significant historical event known as 'The Holocaust.' Write several detailed sentences for each of the photos using appropriate historical terms and concepts.
- Having the photos in a logical sequential order to inform the viewer about the order and details of the events that occurred during the years 1938 to 1945 in Europe that became known as 'The Holocaust'.
- This photo essay must be in a multimodal format. You are to select the platform for creating this photo essay from the list below:
 - Google Sites
 - Prezi.com
 - Google Slides

(If you wish to use another platform you must see Mrs Eustace before starting your first draft please.)

Instructions (2) Students will write a 150-250 word Reflection on your photo essay explaining

How do you think the 16 photos and information you researched for each image, fully described the significant event known as the Holocaust that took place in Europe during World War Two

A list of the resources you used must be submitted with your assessment and your chosen photos must have the source title or link displayed under each photo.
