2. Investigate the following features of a specific hazard and present them in a **geographical report**:
- geographical processes that cause the hazard (150 words)
 - construct a map (digital or hand drawn) to show the spatial location and extent of hazard , write a short description to explain the map and extent (50 words)
 - detailed description of the economic, social and environmental impacts of the hazard (200 words)
 - evaluate the responses to the hazard and how effective was the recovery (200 words) valuable
