CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

All teams are required to provide an umpire/referee and scorer. Teams that withdraw after registration has been accepted will forfeit their registration fee.

COSTS:

Donation fee \$60.00 per team. No refunds unless COVID restrictions cause cancellation.

NSW Government Schools will be issued with an inter-school journal for your Boorowa Touch/Netball nominations.

Archdiocesan Schools will be issued with an inter-school journal for your nominations.

For Non- Government Schools/ACT Government schools will be invoiced once nominations have been received.

FUNDRAISING:

This is a Boorowa fundraising day. It is not appropriate for any other school to conduct their fundraising at this Carnival.

DISPUTES/INCIDENTS:

A designated delegate from the school must report an incident/dispute or complaint to either Touch/Netball control.

TIME OF ARRIVAL:

Please note that all participating schools that attend this carnival will need to arrive at the venue by 8.30am as games commence at 9.00am and will conclude by 3.20pm. As it is a normal school day each participating school is responsible for providing sufficient staff to provide adequate supervision for the students of their own school throughout the entire day.

WET WEATHER:

Carnival will only be canceled in the event of a severe electrical storm or the unforeseeable closure of the playing fields and showground. If in doubt, tune into AM Radio 2LF (93.9FM), Wagga Wagga 2WG, Canberra ABC or Orange ABC.

COMPETITION DRAW:

Draws will be placed on either school websites during Week 1, Term 4 (NSW) & emailed to schools. This will include details of game times. These will be updated as changes occur.

SCORERS:

Netball Scorers: will use clipboards assigned to each court. The scorers from both teams playing in a game must stand beside one another to record the scores, winning team please return score sheet to Netball Control.

Touch Scoring: The scoring of touch games will not be recorded. If you wish for score sheets to keep track of your team, please see touch control on the day.



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PARKING: DISABLED PARKING

Parking will be available free of charge in STRICTLY designated areas at the showground. Please advise if anyone requires Disabled Parking prior to the carnival. Please nose in around the Racetrack.

CATERING:

Catering facilities will be available on site. Kiosks will be operating on the day at both netball and touch fields. A variety of hot and cold foods and drinks will be available. A menu list will be available on the websites closer to the event.

FIRST AID:

Each participating school must have at least one teacher with first aid qualifications accompanying their own school students. All schools are responsible for providing their teams with sunscreen and basic First Aid kits (gloves, strapping tape, band aids, etc) for minor injuries. Blood rules will be enforced.

At the umpire's discretion, in the event of serious injury, competing teams and spectators will be transferred away from an injured player receiving attention and continue their game on another court or field if available.

Fully qualified First Aid personnel will be in attendance all day please contact either Netball or Touch Control for assistance or officials wearing vests.

LOST PROPERTY:

Lost property will be left in a box at the Tournament Control Areas during the day and a list will be put on the school websites.

SEATING/SHADE AREAS & NO BARBEQUES:

Supporters and participants should bring their own portable seating or ground cover/rugs. Team sun shelters are also recommended.

BARBEQUES are not to be used due to OH&S LEGISLATION.

TOILETS:

Some toilet facilities are located at the Touch fields and the Netball courts. However ample toilet facilities are located at the Grandstand and Sheep yard areas.

DRINKING WATER:

Please bring your own drinking water or purchase water from the Kiosks. Water taps have been identified with town and bore water for your information.
