Thank you for your nominations to this year's carnival. We have had a tremendous response from schools and looking forward to running the Carnival again

1. Please note that all Touch and Netball draws and **All** information is available by accessing Boorowa Central Schools or St Josephs Boorowa websites and clicking on the carnival link.
www.boorowa.c.schools.nsw.edu.au or www.stjboorowa.nsw.edu.au
Please check site regularly for any updates.
2. All SCHOOL CO-ORDINATORS please report to **both netball and touch control** to indicate arrival, collect updated draws and carnival packs. Note: Draws may differ to published version due to unforeseen circumstances. To reduce paper usage, **Touch will be trialling an opt-in only if you would like Carnival Packs printed for you.** If you would still like your touch pack printed, please email boorowa-c.school@det.nsw.edu.au by the COB 18th October requesting your pack be printed still. If there are late changes to your draws, we will print these and give them to you on the day.
3. Just a reminder that **each team**, have to provide their **own touch footballs and netballs** and must be clearly labelled with schools name, **bibs for netball, referee or umpire and whistle. Could teachers ensure all long fingernails have been clipped before matches and SOFT Brimmed hats are worn (No hard peaked caps & No jewellery)**
4. **Please note your refereeing duties.** All teams will be refereeing their own games i.e. both Touch and Netball. If you have difficulties please consult Touch or Netball officials.
5. Venue: Boorowa Showground – please see **Parking Information Package**. It is advised that all teams should be at the grounds by 8.30 am, due to enormous amount of traffic.
6. For the safety and comfort of your team players all pre-existing injuries should be strapped or attended to by the team coach prior to commencement of play.
7. Each participating school must have at least one teacher with first aid qualifications to accompany their own school and a first aid kit. In the event of injuries, an adult must accompany students to the first aid tent.
8. All participants will receive a certificate of participation. The Certificate proforma has been emailed to schools to be printed off for your students.
9. Canteens on the Netball and Touch side will operate all day. Price list is on the website. (Bottles of drinking water can be purchased from canteen)
10. Teams are advised to bring shade shelters due to limited shade on grounds & slip slap and slop. **NO BBQ'S ARE TO BE USED**
11. **Do not drink bore water – all taps have signs indicating their source - water drinking stations available at the Touch & Netball Controls.**

Remember the aim of the carnival is participation and good sportsmanship
All schools are responsible for their own students and areas.

Parking Arrangements for 2024 Carnival

Dear Sports co-ordinators

Thank you everyone for your wonderful response to our Carnival. We are very excited to see everyone again!!

Once again, we are expecting huge traffic for the day; we suggest leaving early or using alternative routes if possible other than the Lachlan Valley Way.

Parking arrangements for the day:

Drop off for equipment prior to **8.00am**, gates to the playing areas will be closed.

Parking for cars will be on the racetrack

- Netball Cars enter through **Gate 1, turn left** and will be directed to park, please park as directed by volunteers with no nose in parking. Cars may exit at the end of the day through **Gates 1, 2 or 3.**
- Buses & Coaches will enter at **Gate 1** and exit through **Gate 2. Larger Buses** may need to use Gate 3 with the help of traffic controllers.
- Touch Cars enter through **Gate 3, turn right onto racetrack** and park as directed, with all cars to **park nose in** as directed by volunteers. Cars may exit at the end of the day through **Gates 1, 2 or 3.**
- Disabled Parking Cars - **Touch** enter through **Gate 3** for Disabled Parking **cross the racetrack** and park on **tarred carpark. Netball** enter through **Gate 1**, park near the green shed near the coffee van.
- Limited parking on Ballyryan Road (nose in) Geraldine Street (parallel).
- Car parking will be available at St Joseph's Oval, Scott Street & Boorowa Recreation Club cnr Market and Jugiong Street.
- Limited Parking for cars will be in Scott Street between Queen & South Street, – please note parallel parking – **NO PARKING IN DRIVE WAYS OR ON NATURE STRIPS.**
- Limited parking behind St Patrick's Church & toilets available at the back of the Church.
- Please advise if you require **disability parking**. We will send parking permits to your school to enable those cars to park in the designated area in the bitumen car park near the Touch Kiosk

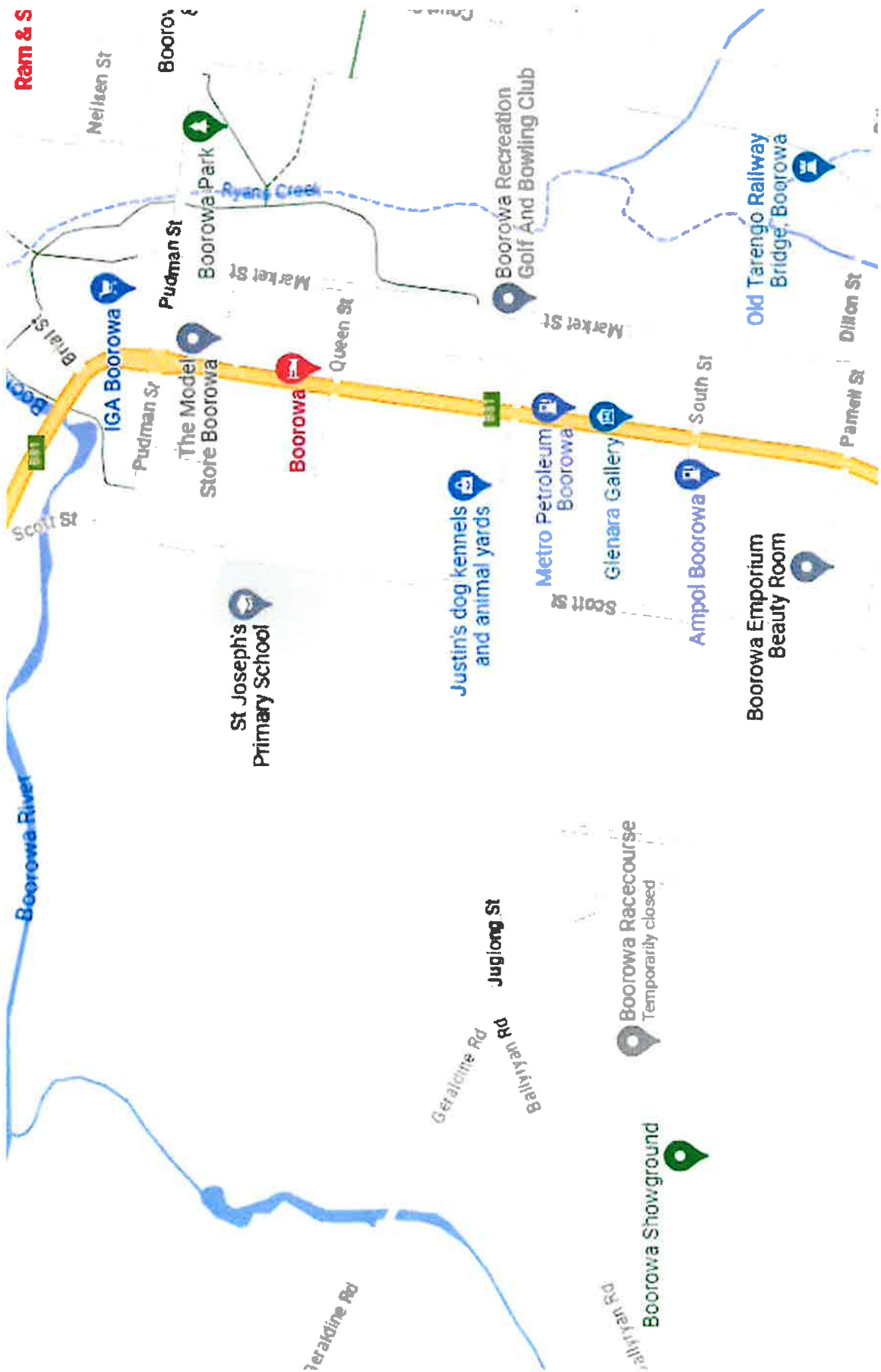

Codes of Conduct



FOR PLAYERS

- Be a good sport.
- Play for enjoyment.
- Work hard for your team as well as yourself.
- Treat all teammates and opponents as you enjoy being treated yourself.
- Play by the rules.
- Cooperate with the team and game officials.
- Control your behaviour on and off the field.
- Learn to value honest effort, skilled performance and improvement.

FOR TEACHERS AND COACHES

- Set a good example for your players.
- Encourage and create opportunities to develop individual skills.
- Teach a wide range of team skills.
- Ensure that the sport is appropriate for the age group and skill development level of the players involved.
- Teach your players to be friendly towards officials and opponents.
- Give all interested students a chance to participate in training and in games.
- Remove from the field of play any of your players whose behaviour is not acceptable.
- Keep your own knowledge of coaching and the development of the game up to date.

FOR PARENTS

- Encourage participation by your children.
- Provide a good model of good sports behaviour for your child to copy.
- Be courteous in your communication with players, team officials, game officials and sport administrators.
- Encourage honest effort, skilled performance and team loyalty.
- Make any new parents feel welcome on all occasions.
- Do not interfere with the conduct of any events.

FOR SPECTATORS

- Demonstrate appropriate social behaviour.
- Remember children play for enjoyment. Don't let your behaviour detract from their enjoyment.
- Let game officials conduct events without interference.
- Support skilled performances and team play with generous applause.
- Demonstrate respect for opposing players and their supporters.
