Parking Arrangements for 2025 Carnival

Parking arrangements for the day:

Equipment drop off is limited strictly prior to 8.00am. Gates to the playing areas will be closed at 8:00am

- Gate 1 Netball turn left on entering/Disability Parking for Netball
- Gate 1 Buses/Drop Offs turn right on entering and exit at Gate 2
- Gate 2 EXIT ONLY Drops offs exit as per traffic controller through Gate 2
- Gate 3 Touch/Disabled Parking/volunteers

Parking for cars will be on the racetrack

- Cars enter through Gate 1 for Netball and turn left.
- Cars enter through Gate 3 for Touch, enter the racetrack and turn right
- Cars enter through Gate 3 for Disabled Parking, cross the racetrack and park on tarred carpark
- Buses to turn right at Gate 1 and proceed to designated area as per traffic controller and Bus Parkers. Buses will exit through Gate 2. Larger Buses may need to use Gate 3 with the help of traffic controllers.
- Drop offs, will go in Gate 1 and Drop Off at designated spot & then will exit through Gate 2 following the instructions of the traffic controller and signage
- Touch/Netball cars will be directed to park as per instructions of the traffic marshals around the Race Track.
- Limited parking on Ballyryan Road (nose in) and on Geraldine Street (parallel).
- Car parking will be available at St Joseph's Oval, Scott Street & Boorowa Recreation Club, cnr Market and Jugiong Street.
- Limited Parking for cars will be in Scott Street between Queen & South Street,— please note parallel parking NO PARKING IN DRIVE WAYS OR ON NATURE STRIPS.
- Please advise the amount of disability car parks your school requires so that we can make
 the space available. Cars must have their disability permit visible on entry to enable Parking
 attendants to park them in the correct place.
